REGISTRATION

NOTE: Social security numbers will be mandatory to complete registration.

Students register according to the time assigned by the Summer Sessions Office on the registration time permit, mailed out as applications from students are received. (See *Application for Registration Time Permit* in the front of this bulletin.) This registration time permit card *must be presented* at registration for the Fresno Campus First Session. Registration time permits are not necessary for the Second Session at Fresno, nor for short workshops.

Registration for the First Session at Fresno is on Monday, June 17, 8 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m., in the Men's Gymnasium.

Registration for evening classes will be on Monday, June 17, 5 p.m. to 8 p.m., Summer Sessions Office, Thomas Administration Building Room 132. However, students may register for evening classes at regular registration during the day. Monday night classes will meet for instruction.

Registration for the First Session at Visalia will be held at the College of the Sequoias at the first class meeting.

On Monday, July 29, students will register for the Fresno Second Session classes. See Second Session at Fresno section of bulletin for detailed instructions. Registration for courses beginning Monday, July 29, for the Second Session at Visalia will be held at the College of the Sequoias at the first class meeting. For courses beginning after July 29, students may register either Monday, July 29, or on the first day class is scheduled.

Registration and payment of fees must be made in person by the student during the registration period, and are not accepted by mail. No out-of-state fee is required of non-resident students in the summer sessions.

A \$5.00 fine is assessed for late registration at any time after days and hours announced for registration.

Registration is complete only when all required forms are completed and filed and all fees are paid.

EXTENSION CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT

Summer Session students may enroll concurrently for Summer and Extension classes. Full credit will be given for all classes completed by this arrangement. See last section of Summer Session Bulletin for Schedule of summer extension classes.

Students are reminded the maximum unit limitation still applies to summer class enrollments.
