DEBTS OWED TO THE COLLEGE

From time to time the student may become indebted to the college. Debts occur, for example, when the student fails to repay money borrowed from the college or he fails to pay college dormitory or library fees or for other services provided by the college at his request. Should this occur, Sections 42380 and 42381 of *Title 5 of the California Administrative Code* authorize the college to withhold "permission to register, to use facilities for which a fee is authorized to be charged, to receive services, materials, food, or merchandise or any combination of the above from any person owing a debt" until the debt is paid. Under these provisions the college may withhold permission to register and may withhold other services such as grades and transcripts. If a student feels that he does not owe all or part of a particular fee or charge, he should contact the college business office. That office, or another office to which the student is referred, will review the pertinent information, including information the student may wish to present, and will advise the student of its conclusions with respect to the debt.
