Even with our pre-war office staff it would be a long and difficult job to do this exactly, but after making a few accurate checks of costs for such items as "Water", "San Simeon Village," etc., it would seem that the enclosed general "breakdown" would be fairly close to actual cost, even though an insurance adjuster might not allow the costs of evolution to enter, as our records do.
