


6. **Order of Business**

- F. **WEJP** – Commissioner Figueroa brought up the subject of grass roots fundraising. It was decided to add the subject to our Retreat Agenda. Regarding WEJP, the next meeting is on June 18 at the Santa Barbara Carrows at 9:00 a.m.
- G. **Community Commission of Ventura County 'Homeless Report'**. Betty Krause is the staff person. Next meeting is June 27 from 1-3 p.m. It's usually held at the County Health Bldg on Gonzalez.
- H. **ACCW quarterly meeting of May 20, 2005 Report:** Commissioner Goodrow attended the meeting, Santa Clara County Commission on the Status of Women "Social Issues Agenda". Items included: "Female Inmates"; "Legislation"; "The Cardea Project"; CEDAW Task Force. Discussion: Would these project work in your County?
- I. **RRN Update:** "Write for your Rights" meeting, Sunday, August 28, Women's Equality Day at Temple Beth Torah from 2-4 p.m. They will have a table with a letter on one of the reproductive issues that can be signed. Commissioner Steele suggested that we could have a table there if we decide to. Possibly Commissioners Riggan and Goodrow could staff it. What materials? Brochures and newsletter, banner, storyboard? Commissioners all agreed this is a good idea. Commissioner Hollister will add it to the website.
