

PUBLIC SCHOOL CREDENTIALS
 (For revised credential structure see *Education Division*)

Fresno State College is authorized by the State Department of Education to recommend candidates for the credentials for public school service listed below. All students must meet certain minimum requirements prior to admission to a credential program. These requirements are listed in the *Education Division*. Holders of bachelor's degrees must complete a minimum of 15 semester units in residence at Fresno State College to qualify for a college recommended teaching credential. For the administration, supervision, general pupil personnel services, and general secondary credentials, candidates must complete at least one-half of the postgraduate work in residence.

Students who had completed two years of college and who on July 1, 1963, were enrolled in the teacher education curriculum may qualify for the public school credentials listed below on the basis of the programs described in the *General Catalog* provided they complete the requirements within established time limits. *Students who had not completed two years of college and who were not enrolled in the teacher education curriculum on July 1, 1963, must qualify under the revised credential structure. See Education Division and departments concerned for requirements.*
