

units for credit during the first six week session and six units for credit during the second five week session. Classes are scheduled to be held on the California State University, Fresno campus, the College of the Sequoias in Visalia and outlying areas in the California State University, Fresno service area. Second session students are cautioned if they expect to earn six units of credit they must use the full five weeks for classes.

Students attending both the Fresno first and second sessions may earn a total of 13 units of credit during the summer. In addition to offering courses five weeks in length, the second session includes short intensive courses conducted on a laboratory or workshop basis, during which the student devotes full time to just one course. The courses run one or more weeks depending on the number of units to be earned. Continuance of any course depends on the number of students enrolling.

The workshops and special features provide opportunities for intensive practical work in selected areas, such as: business, industrial arts, music, narcotic education, special education, etc. See Special Features section.
