Directions to Campus

Traveling North on Route 101

- Traveling through San Luis Obispo, take the Highway 1 North exit.
- Turn right onto Highway 1/Santa Rosa Street.
- Turn right onto Highland Drive.
- Follow the Event Parking area signs.

Traveling South on Route 101

- Traveling through San Luis Obispo, take the Highway 1 North exit toward Morro Bay.
- Turn right at the stop sign and travel north on Santa Rosa Street/Highway 1.
- Turn right onto Highland Drive.
- Follow the Event Parking area signs.

Traveling South on Highway 1:

- Approaching San Luis Obispo, the first stop light on the edge of town is Highland Drive.
- Turn left onto Highland Drive.
- Follow the Event Parking area signs.

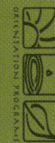
Parking

- Parking is limited on Friday. We encourage you to carpool, if possible. Thank you.

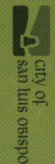
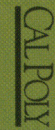

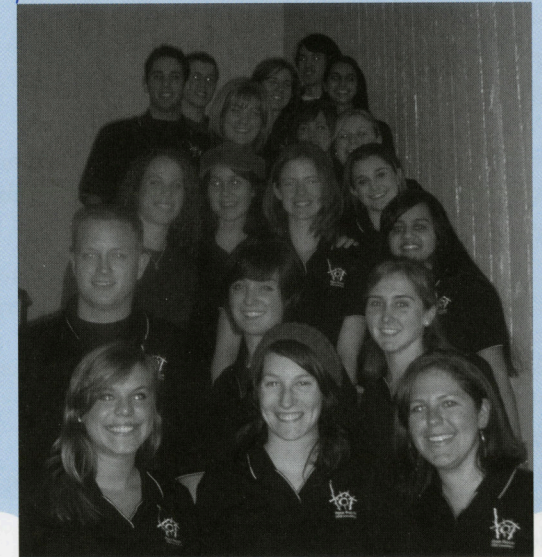
