

**270. Seminar in United States (3)**

Prerequisite: see instructor. Selected research problems in United States history.

**278. Recent Interpretations of American History (3)**

Prerequisite: see instructor. Examination of selected problems in American history in light of new research discoveries; extensive use of scholarly journals.

**285. Seminar in Far Eastern History (3)**

Prerequisite: History 100 or permission of instructor. Research in specific areas of Far Eastern history and culture.

**289. Seminar in California History (3)**

Prerequisite: Hist 100, 189A, 189B. Research on special problems in California history.

**290. Independent Study (1-3; max see reference)**

See *Academic Placement—Independent Study*.

**292. Directed Reading (1-3; max total 6 if no area repeated)**

Prerequisite: classified standing. Readings on selected themes, problems, and topics in consultation with a faculty adviser.

**299A-B. Thesis (3-3)**

Prerequisite: see *Master's Degrees—Thesis Requirement*. Preparation, completion, and submission of an acceptable thesis for the master's degree. A. Thesis design. B. Thesis writing. A and B may be taken concurrently.
