WOMEN'S OUTREACH MEETING....JANUARY, 1990
OUTCOMES

Based on the results of the Women's Needs Assessment Survey and the Meeting Evaluation Form, the meeting was successful in that we met our goals:

- (1) Securing community input.
- (2) Discussing local concerns, and
- (3) Familiarization of VCCFW (Ventura County Commission for Women) accomplishments and goals for 1990 and beyond.

Women's Needs Assessment Survey results:

21 of the 35 women in attendance completed the Needs Assessment Survey. Although income levels vary, the analysis of the survey reflected women (in the Conejo Valley) between the ages of 30-59 who generally need assistance in similar areas: affordable housing, eldercare, child care, financial planning, legal aide, substance abuse, education, job skills, career opportunities, food assistance, and alternative work schedules. Meeting Evaluation Results:

20 of the 35 women in attendance completed evaluation forms. All 20 felt meeting content was helpful and informative. They especially liked the open discussion portion of the agenda. See outcomes of the Evaluation Form on the attached chart.
