Discussions	State Budget Big 5 are currently meeting (Governor, 2 Republican Leaders and 2 Democrat Leaders) to update the budget for 08-09 to include increased taxes and spending cuts. For the CSU, the cut in October was 33 million (479,100 to CSUCI) and the current cut is an additional 66 million (990,000 to CSUCI). State is now issuing IOU's to vendors and individuals for tax refunds. March payroll is expected to be IOU's to State employees. Chancellors Office is not sure if this will include Cal State employees or not.
