For those visitors who are undecided about paying the high cost of Survival, the Faire provides—free—all manner of previews of Earth as it will be if the people don't choose to pay the price set for Survival.

Survival is offered for sale in many guises and can be purchased by every person visiting the Faire. The purchase price is each person's desire to have mankind survive.
