SUBJECT: NAHRO Convention on July 23 and 24

As I mentioned to you this morning, the City of Oxnard Housing Authority is one of the joint sponsors of the NAHRO Meeting to be held at the Casa Sirena Motor Hotel on July 23 and 24. I am attaching information sheets for each of the Council Members and for staff of your office. If you, any of your staff, or any members of the City Council are able to attend, please contact me as soon as possible so that we can make appropriate arrangements.

Mr. Wallace is coordinating the entire function and has indicated to me that time can be made available at either the dinner on Monday night or at the luncheon on Tuesday for the Mayor or any member of the City Council to welcome the NAHRO Delegates to Oxnard. We have received approximately 60 advance reservations and anticipate the total attendance to be in the neighborhood of 80. The delegates are primarily from the Central California Area; although representatives from Los Angeles and other areas of Southern California will also be in attendance.

It is my understanding that during the dinner on Monday evening, the NAHRO Officers will honor George Wallace for his many years of outstanding service as Executive Director of the Oxnard Housing Authority. I can make arrangements to include a representative from the City of Oxnard in this portion of the program if it is deemed appropriate. Perhaps the Mayor could present a key to the city or a letter of commendation to Mr. Wallace for his 28 years of service to the Oxnard Housing Authority.
