The meeting was open to the public & the Agenda was posted. The Chair called the meeting to order at 6:54 p.m.; As the Recording Secretary was not present and there were no volunteers, the Chair served as Recording Secretary. The Chair read the Mission Statement.

2. Present in response to Roll Call were Chair Lee Riggan, Vice Chair Diana Goodrow, Treasurer Jan Lawrence (Arr. 7:01 p.m.) Commissioners Nancy Lee Phillips, Ruth A. Funk, Elvia Guizar, Shante Morgan-Durisseau (Arr. 6:53 p.m.), Debra Bagley. A quorum was present.

5 Action Items:

a) After much discussion it was moved by Commissioner Phillips and seconded by Commissioner Goodrow that the request be approved for the allocation of funds from the VCCF/VCCW Fund for up to \$2,500.00 for the "Status of Women & Girls in Ventura County Report". The motion passed unanimously.

b) By general consent the Chair was directed to question VCCF on the following points:
 1) Define in detail the tasks VCCF will carry out in managing the grant under the \$2,500 fee;

2) Define the timeline for the final decision and disbursement of funds by VCCF for the grants to VCCW;

3) Exactly how much is the grant being considered by the WLF; and, when is the Fairburn funding available; 4) Please clarify the matching funds purpose that was asked for;

5) In a fundraising campaign for whom would donor checks be written to?

6) Please provide a template that may be used for the consultant description for the project management of the Status of Women & Girls Report.

c) It was moved by Commissioner Phillips and seconded by Commissioner Durisseau to table Item 5.(b) to the next meeting, the consideration that VCCW conduct a fundraising campaign to raise matching funds from friends and supporters to support our effort to conduct the study and develop the "Status of Women & Girls in Ventura County Report."

6. Discussion:

 VCCW will continue to retain its meeting space at its Ventura office. Commissioner Goodrow will inform County Staff of this determination.

b. Fundraising for the Status Report under future consideration may be included in the Consultant Tasks.

c. Interns for VCCW will be considered for its utilization in the design of the project management.

d. Four Teams for the Status of Women Study will be considered in designing the project management.
