As of Sunday, January 9, 4:00 P.M. there is severe flooding on many of the roads surrounding the campus of CSUCI and University Glen.

Due to rising waters, University Drive on the campus has been closed. All those driving to and from the campus must use Portrero Road to enter or exit the campus. As of this time officials have also closed Cawelti Road to all vehicles.

University officials advise all travelers to use extreme caution and to obey all signs posted on roads surrounding the University.

As of this time, the University has been notified that the availability of Potrero Road to access the campus is also subject to change.
