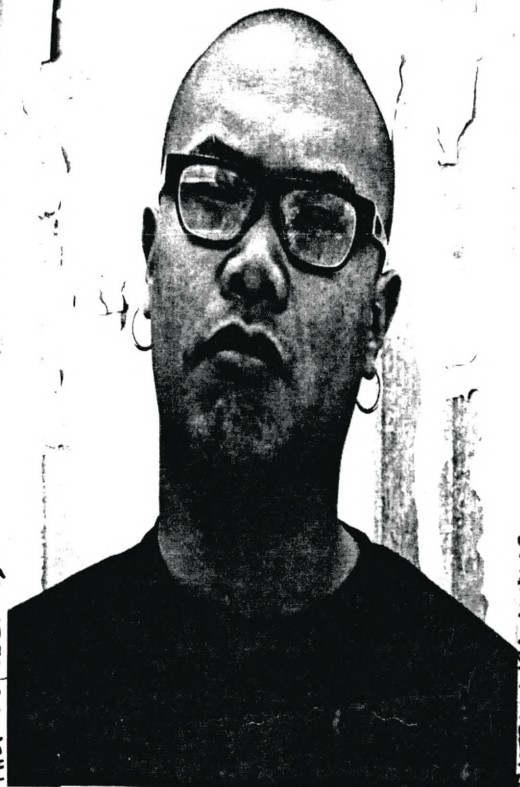
Luis ALFARO
