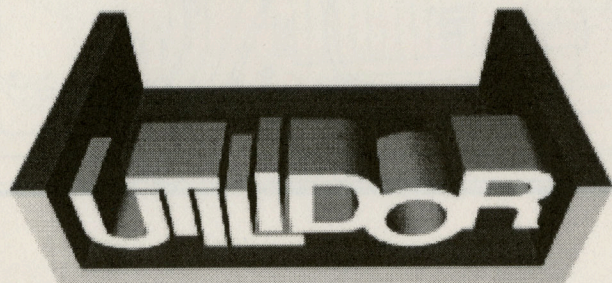

This project was created because our current system is unreliable, wasteful, and in some cases over a century old.

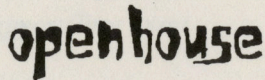
