#### EDUCATION CODE OF CALIFORNIA

SECTION 12200. Each county or city and county board of education may provide for the registration of any credential or life diploma issued by the State Board of Education. Such registration shall be deemed to be the issuance of a certificate to the holder of such credential or life diploma. Such registration shall authorize the service of the holder in the county in the capacity in which and for the period of time which the credential or life diploma is valid.

## Procedure Governing Renewal of This Credential

The responsibility for renewal of this credential rests upon the holder. This credential may be renewed during the period commencing January 1 of the year it expires and ending with the date of its expiration. The renewal application should, whenever possible, be submitted at least one month prior to the date the credential expires.

Address renewal applications to State Department of Education, Commission of Credentials, Sacramento 14, California.

The renewal application consists of:

A. A letter requesting renewal.

B. A health certificate as prescribed by the State Board of Education.

NOTE.—The health examination form may be obtained from the Commission of Credentials.

NOTE.—This requirement is waived during the continuance of the National emergency caused by World War II.

C. The legal fee of three dollars in the form of a money order or certified check. Personal checks can not be accepted.

D. Verification of completion of requirements, if any, listed below.

E. Verification of recency of training by official transcripts of record, or of recency of experience by original letter or letters from responsible person or persons having knowledge of the facts, as follows:

The applicant shall verify either (a) at least five months of successful school experience during the preceding five years, or (b) completion during the preceding five-year period of at least six semester units of upper division or graduate work in an approved educational institution, or (c) a minimum of five months of experience in education work of a type and in an amount which satisfies the Commission of Credentials that he is acquainted with present day educational practices.

NOTE.—During the continuance of the National emergency caused by World War II, this credential may be renewed to June 30 following its date of expiration without meeting this requirement.

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO GRADUATES:

The attached document is your teaching credential, which you are to file in the office of the county superintendent of schools in the county in which you teach.

Please note that this credential bears an expiration date. It is your responsibility to keep your credential valid, and if allowed to expire it can not be renewed.

It is our understanding that renewal will be granted by the State Department of Education if you secure a minimum of five months of successful teaching experience in the public schools of California during the life of the credential. Some time prior to the expiration date (at least a month), send official verification of this amount of experience to the Division of Credentials, State Department of Education, Sacramento, together with a postal money order or certified check for \$3.00, and a letter requesting renewal of your credential (give its number and type; i.e., general elementary, art secondary, etc.) Your county superintendent will supply you with the official verification of experience.

If you are unable to secure the required amount of teaching experience during the life of the credential, you should write to the State Department of Education at least six months in advance of the expiration date, requesting that alternative renewal requirements be named. It is probable that a summer session of additional schooling will be specified, so it is important that you ascertain the requirement far enough in advance that you can complete it before the expiration date.
