Steering Committee Decisions (all without objection), 13 members present

- 1) A delegation roll call will be taken by the row tellers (generally occupants of seats 10 and 14) as soon as the convention convenes so that the absentees' seats may be filled by alternates. PLEASE BE PROMPT.
- 2) Changing vote on First Roll Call. Changes may be made on forms in the hands of the Secretary or the Assistant Secretary, Eugene Lee. Instructions for changing vote appear on the form. Changes must be made before the call of the roll of states commences (before the convention chairman calls "Alabama"). Forms can only be turned in while the convention or a caucus is in session.
- 3) Subsequent Roll Calls. The tally taken at the NBC meeting will remain the tally for subsequent roll calls, subject to change executed on the change forms. However, if 33 or more delegates request, the delegation will be repolled.
- 4) Caucuses. If the occasion arises (Vice President, etc) for caucuses, they will be held at the call of the Chairman or 20% of the delegates (nearest adequate rooms in Museum of Science and Industry).
