













#### **FALL SPORTS SEE GAINS**








A determined effort by each member of the Pioneer Women's Cross Country team enabled them to capture a second consecutive AIAW National Championship at Seattle. The Pioneers won the title going away. Standouts for Hayward were Michele Aubuchon and Stefani Stoutt who received All American recognition by finishing third and fourth respectively at the national meet.

In football Cal State tied Chico State for second place in the FWC with a 3-2 record in the conference and a 6-4 mark for the season. Hayward ended the season on a strong note by defeating St. Mary's College 30-0. Ron Greene was the leading rusher for the season with 747 yards on 182 carries and six touchdowns. He also caught 16 passes for another two TD's.

The water polo team had a successful season with a 12-15 over-all record. The Pioneers lost a 14-12 heartbreaker to Davis in their last meet. Lloyd Cardone was the season's leading scorer with 52 goals.

The men's cross country team placed fifth in the FWC championships. Jay Peters was Hayward's top finisher with a time of 33:17 in the 10,000 meter course.

The soccer team finished third in the FWC, and the women's volleyball team took a seventh in the GSC championships.

Gary Scholl (inset), ranked third, anticipates serve.




In men's basketball the Pioneers suffered their worst season ever as they finished seventh in the FWC with a 2-10 record and 3-24 overall. Senior guard Dino Clark led the team scoring with an average of 12.9 points a game. Forward Tom Klingenbeck was named all-FWC while Clark and James Endo made honorable mention.


The women's basketball team enjoyed its most successful season since 1974 by finishing fourth in the GSC with a 9-5 mark and 17-10 overall. The Pioneers had a balanced scoring attack led by Vicki Hannsford with a 13.2 point per game average.

The men's tennis team, five-time FWC champions, went through a rebuilding season in 1981. Three returning players were Scott Montgomery, Andy Bean, and Jeff Southwick.

Both the women's and men's swimming teams had very good seasons. The women swam to second place in the GSC and eighth in the AIAW nationals. They were led by Co-captains Olivia Moore, butterflyer, and Pam Williams, breaststroker, and sparked by freestyler Tricia Price, and divers Lori Stilson and Donna Baker. The men finished third in the FWC, led by backstroker George Osterberg, captain. At the nationals in Ohio, Osterberg won third place in the backstroke. And the Hayward men swimmers captured 10th place in Ohio—the best the Pioneers have ever done at the national meet.

# 1980-81 INTRAMURALS GET WIDE SUPPORT




Director Jack Holleman was assisted by Carol Hale, who encouraged involvement by anyone, especially women.




















## BUSY DRAMA SEASON AT CSUH

To those who knew him as a friend, he was a willing listener and a sage


adviser with a genuine interest in those who needed him.

As I write this, I wear the ring I had seen


him wear all the years I've known him.










#### **ALUMNI ASSOCIATION AND SCHOOL COUNCILS**


Something that the Alumni offers the university is a scholarship which is given to a student in each of the four schools based on service given to the university and participation in university-related events.

The Alumni also founded the Ale Haus where all the proceeds go into a scholatship fund.


To be able to do more, the Alumni needs you and your fresh new ideas and energy.
