November 21st 1878

Dear Boy.

I have two letters from you
unanswered - received yesterday and the
day before. I've been having my usual
bad heads and not able to write, but
am now all right again. I was much
interested in your letters and Mr Yawbroad
hopes he'll like the house and prove a
good tenant. Give my love to the Taylors
Susan cries when I give your love to her.
I've just finished a new dark brown
dress for her and it's trimmed with
gold braid & buttons and looks fine.
Mother gave the material - I am now
going to make Emma a grey and
cardinal one - out of stuff donated -

Father is well. So are all the children
but Sam and I don't know what is the
matter with him. But when it stops
raining I'll take him to a Doctor
and find out. Don't you worry about
the children - you know I'll do as well
by them as you could and that you can
be of no use - so mind your side of the
house and write me sensible letters.

I read you Hollie Watsons marriage
in the paper before I left. and you
said it could not be her - because it
would have said her father's name.

I am real sorry for her mother - Glad
you had a nice time there.

Mrs Henry Morgan came to see me this
week with Sarah. they were both well
and all her family. I could not let
her see Arny he behaves so bad
hides his face and yells whenever

anyone comes into the house - his
Auntie hates him - he does not behave
as I could wish - Emma spends much
of her time down stairs with Sarah "working"
she says - she is very lively - Dudu and
Pam have learned to knit and
they cut pictures and paste to their
hearts content, they have real nice times.
Mother is about the same, I think better -
but Julia don't - It has been a wet week.
Julia and her children are well.

I don't send Dudu to school for I've no
money and if I had, don't think I would
as her eyes trouble her every day - let her
play this winter and when I get back
to Oakland she can commence again.
If you give up the house in Danvers we
can probably find another when we
return - particularly if you strike
a "Bonanza" - as you must -

I'll write again when I get time, the
children all send love to Papa.
