

My buddy Bob Rodriguez who is attending the National GI Forum Convention in Chicago wrote the following article which appeared recently in the San Jose News. In it he expresses a few of the many reasons why the American GI Forum opposes the extension of Public Law 78, The Bracero Program. I received his permission to reprint it in my column.

#### BRACERO LABOR

Editor: May I make a few remarks regarding your editorial of August 6th wherein you favor extension of the bracero program?

I agree with you when you say that "unquestionably the bracero program has been of great benefit to many California farmers." It no doubt has but at the expense of many Mexican American families whose wages have been depressed by the importation of Braceros. The Bracero Program makes a mockery of our free enterprise system, and is contrary to the basic principles of democracy which we as veterans fought and died for.

You at times featured articles pointing out the high delinquency rate and welfare case load of Mexican Americans. It is rather difficult for many Mexican American families who depend on a livelihood from farm work to raise model children when the right to compete in an economy of supply and demand is being denied them. Domestic labor is available but not at stoop wages.

Our own farm working citizens do not enjoy the benefits rendered to Braceros. Our distinguished Congressman, Charles Gubser, when addressing the House of Representatives urging the extension of the Bracero Program and pointing out the humane treatment offered them said, "Have you ever eaten in a Bracero Camp in one of their tables which are always spotlessly clean? Their kitchens pass rigid health inspections. I have eaten at these tables and it is good food as good as you get downstairs in the House Restaurant."

I wonder if Congressman Gubser would find the same situation at the table of one of our migrant families?

The American GI Forum of California has always been, is, and will always be against this miserable slave labor program which has been detrimental to the progress of thousands of Mexican American families. It is an immoral program and contrary to everything American.

The only justification for it is the gain of those who benefit from it.
