SUBSTANCE ABUSE PROGRAM 1

Director - Mary Albert, M.S., R.N.

- Alcohol abuse program for adults voluntarily seeking help. Immediate, intensive treatment and evaluation, plus rehabilitation for those with mental disorders related to alcohol abuse.
- Drug abuse program for adults requiring 24-hour care. The program is integrated with and complements community projects such as halfway houses and follow-up programs.

INTENSIVE PSYCHIATRIC INTERVENTION PROGRAM 2A

Director - Rose Marie Voelker, B.S., R.N.

- For adults exhibiting such serious emotional problems as acute depression, anxiety, panic states, acute catatonic and other schizophrenic conditions.

PSYCHIATRIC REHABILITATION PROGRAM 2R

Director - Kate Allen, M.S.W.

- Psychiatric rehabilitation for mentally ill adults with problems in social behavior and interpersonal relationships.

INTENSIVE PSYCHIATRIC INTERVENTION PROGRAM 3A

Director -- Robert Voelker, M.D.

- For adults suffering from a sudden onset of depression, anxiety or panic, acute schizophrenic conditions, or other mental disabilities.

SELF-HELP PROGRAM 4A

Director - Albert Vercoutere, B.S.

- For adults with acute emotional problems or acute exacerbation of pervious illness. Provides realization of emotional limits and utilization of support techniques.

PSYCHIATRIC REHABILITATION PROGRAM 4R

Director - Richard Samelian, M.S.W.

- For adults who need an improved self-image. Develops acceptable work habits, behavior, grooming, and communication abilities.

ADOLESCENT TREATMENT PROGRAM 5A

Director - Henry Marshall, M.S.

- For mentally disabled teenagers, emphasizing education, social relationships, family conflict reduction, psychodrama, and use of leisure time.

ACTING-OUT ADOLESCENT PROJECT (MD) 5B

Director - Don Burns

- For adolescents with severe behavioral problems who are not homicidal. Emphasis of the program will include individualized educational programming, individual and group therapy, in order to motivate the patients to improve their behavior to an acceptable level.

CHILDREN'S TREATMENT PROGRAM 5C

Director - William Miners, M.A.

- For emotionally disturbed children, ages 4-16, emphasizing individualized treatment for each patient with formal education, recreational activities, and community visits.

GERO-PSYCHIATRY AND MULTIPLE-HANDICAPPED ADULTS 6G

Director - Martin Gish, M.D.

- For patients 60 years of age and over who are mentally disordered. The program treats psychosocial and medical needs, encouraging self-sufficiency for reentry into the community.

MEDICAL-SURGICAL PROGRAM 6M

Director - R. E. Mahoney, M.D.

- For those from all treatment programs in the hospital who require specialized medical, surgical, or neurological care.

DEVELOPMENTALLY DISABLED PROGRAMS

PHYSICAL AND SOCIAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM 7

Director - Fremont Koch, M.D.

- For mentally retarded, 14 years and older, with reinforcement of self-help and basic physical skills.

BEHAVIOR ADJUSTMENT PROGRAM 8

Director - L. L. Stephens, R.N.

- For mentally retarded residents who need to develop motivation, self-control, and socially acceptable ways of relating to others.

REHABILITATION PROGRAM 9

Director - Douglas Van Meter

- For mentally retarded residents using a closely-structured Operant Conditioning-Token Economy Program.

SENSORY DEPRIVATION (DD) PROGRAM 11

Director - Kathleen Gransee, B.A.

- To enable the developmentally disabled deaf or deaf-blind to communicate effectively through a total communication system.
