

A. To visit hospitalized relatives. Evacuees may be authorized to visit relatives hospitalized in an outside hospital or other institution in the following cases only.

1. Where the relative is one belonging to the immediate family or one who has been dependent on the member of the family presenting the request.

and

2. Where the Center Manager has definite knowledge that the person to be visited is hospitalized and is in such condition that a visit from a next relative is advisable.

B. Business matters requiring personal attention. Ordinarily arrangements will be made so that business matters can be taken care of at the Center, however in extreme cases where this can not be arranged, passes may be issued for a period of not to exceed eight (8) hours, to visit only local state and federal offices.

C. To answer subpoenas and court orders. Evacuees subpoenaed or ordered to court may be granted permits to leave the Center for a period not to exceed eight (8) hours, only after the Center Manager has satisfied himself that the matter cannot be handled between the court and evacuees within the confines of the Center.
