3. Review of BSIT

The committee expressed concerns with the BSIT degree.

- No consultation with the Business Faculty
- What is the rational for requiring 1 year of lab science? The full year of lab science should be completed at the same institution (all at CC or all at CSUCI)
- Is the intent for this program to become state-funded?
- Can Tenured Track Faculty be hired for Extended Education courses?
- No free electives
- Dictates all of the 9 units of upper-division GE
- What degree will be issued
- No MGT and ECON course developed
- Narrowly focused
- Options/concentrations are not described
