With our new school year of 1970-71 well under way, I thought it appropriate to invite you to visit the Adult School program. We anticipate an enrollment comparable to last year when the spring semester reached an all-time high for the community program with 6406 students enrolled. This included all day and evening adult classes held at Oxnard, Rio Mesa, Camarillo, Newbury Park, Hueneme and Thousand Oaks High Schools and other schools and places throughout the Oxnard Union High School District. The figure of 6406 shows an increase of 688 students over the year before in the number of adults enrolled at any one time.

We are offering this year over 200 classes by a competent staff of 165 instructors covering 80 subject fields. At no time in our history have so many adults been interested in improving themselves through raising their general level of education and vocational competence here in our community.

Many members of our community recognize the need for continued education and are doing something about it. Last year 319 students graduated from the Adult Education program. Most adults are employed, have families and often find it inconvenient or impossible to pursue the type of full-time educational programs offered youth. Most adults, however, who have enrolled in high school adult classes have found their educational pursuits rewarding.
