Health Policy Institute looks at gun violence Feb. 15

Fresno State's Central Valley Health Policy Institute with the Cecil C. Hinton Multicultural Community Center present "Confronting the Consequences of Violence: Healing and Public Health," **3:30-6:30 p.m. Friday, Feb. 15**, at the Hinton Center (2385 S. Fairview Ave). The presentation features Tina Chéry, co-founder of the Louis D.
