

Friend Ship Gets

Late Milk Cargo

LONG BEACH—(AP)—A late flood of canned milk for shipment to Europe's children forced the Friend Ship, the Golden Bear, to delay her sailing until midnight last night.

An estimated 350 tons of canned milk and some clothing were loaded aboard the California Maritime Academy training ship here.

The vessel is due in San Diego by 10 a. m. today to load donations from residents of the southernmost section of the state. It is scheduled to sail Saturday with some 1,400 tons for France, Italy and Greece.

Commodore Russell M. Ihrig, superintendent of the maritime academy, said he has been advised the ship will not be fined by the Customs Department for such inadequate clearance papers at half San Francisco.

Capt. R. M. G. Swany, commanding officer, filed a cargo manifest with the customs office here.
