Now you should have a better understanding of the sweatshop conditions we were forced to labor in by our cold and cheerless editor.


# BIBLE CLUB

Cal Poly launched 9 Argo Robotic Floats for NOAA on Cruise 05. These floats sink to 1000 m and drift for 7 days. Then they sink to 2000 m and rise to the surface taking temperature and salinity data. The floats last about 5 years before their batteries run down, unless they run into a seamount or an island or some other misfortune occurs.






