Gentlemen:

At its regular meeting on April 6, 1971, the Oxnard City Council received a letter from Mr. Enoch which advised of your decision that the provisions of Oxnard's proposed airport agreement were not acceptable to the County. The City Council took note of Mr. Enoch's statement that "There is also a commitment on the part of the Board to seek with (Oxnard) and the Council of the City of Camarillo an agreement with the general provisions that were developed through cooperative efforts in January of 1971".

Although the City Council expressed its disappointment that the Board of Supervisors did not find the City's proposed agreement acceptable, a majority of the Council believes that further effort should be expended to work out a mutually acceptable program for providing and regulating aviation activities at the Oxnard Air Force Base. The City Council, therefore, directed me to request a joint meeting between the Council and the Board of Supervisors in order that future discussions may be held to determine whether an acceptable compromise agreement can be worked out relative to the airport operations and protection of the environment. A majority of the City Council sincerely believes that such future discussions will yield positive results of mutual benefit. If you agree that such a meeting will be beneficial, will you please advise us suggesting the earliest convenient date and time which would be appropriate for such a meeting. Thank you.
