(Cal Poly Sets Two More School Marks, Finishes Second in CCAA Swimming Championships)

Cal Poly swimmers added two more school records to their collection and maintained their second place position as the GCAA swimming championships were concluded on Saturday.

Defending national champion San Diego State easily won the team championship with a whopping 195 points. Cal Poly's runner-up total was 77 points. In third place was Fresno State with 66g followed by Cal Poly Pomona 38, Cal State Los Angeles 31, San Fernando Valley State 30 and Cal State Long Beach 21g.

The toughness of the competition is indicated by the fact that Mustang soph Larry Gray set a Cal Poly record in the 100-yard freestyle preliminaries but did not qualify for the finals in the event. His :51,3 effort was the seventh fastest time in the prelims and only the six fastest make the finals. The old Poly mark was :51.4 set in 1965 by Lyle Rice.

Poly's 800-yard freestyle relay team grabbed a fourth place and set a school mark of 7:53.8. Swimming for the Mustangs were Jim Burror, Earl DeVries, Lerry

Toombs and Don Fishbach. Cal Poly Pomona won the race with a 7:41.5 clocking. The

Mustangs were a full second behind third place San Biego State and 19 seconds ahead

of fifth place Cal State Los Angeles.

Toombs placed fifth in the finals of the 1,650-yard freestyle race. His time was 19:14.6.

Senior Pete Scaroni of Santa Maria was fourth in the 200-yard backstroke with a 2:13.7 time.

Freshmen Bob Bruckert earned a third place finish in the 200-yard breastwicks.

His time was 2:25.8. Fresho State's Terry Harper set a New CCAA record of 2:21.3.

Mustange Jim Burror and Dave Meurer tied for second in the 100-yard butterfly finals. The winner was the Astecs' Mark Bruce with a time of :56.2. It was a blanket finish with one of the official watches crediting Burror with a :56.1 time, a tenth of a second faster than the winner.

Poly diver Ron Swart took sixth in the 3-meter diving finals.
