

Here are five bills enacted upon by the State Assembly in recent months, and five issues that will confront Assembly members in coming months. Please indicate how you would vote on each, and--briefly, please--give some reasons for your vote:

A.B. 15--Enacts comprehensive law to preserve prime agricultural land.

A.B. 1047--Prohibits governmental agencies from examining income tax returns of welfare recipients.

A.B. 841--Prohibits banks from engaging in insurance business.

A.B. 1725--Bans aerosol spray cans after July 1, 1977.

A.B. 1896--Changes Admission Day holiday from Sept. 9 to the second Monday in September.

Would you vote for or against a state property tax to provide education funds and comply with the court order to equalize funding between school districts?

Would you vote for or against a bill requiring a deposit on all beer and soft drink containers?

Would you vote for or against the State Coastal Plan as submitted to the legislature by the State Coastal Commission?

Would you vote to continue the Agricultural Labor Relations Board with its present powers? To restrict those powers? To disband the board entirely?

Do you support or oppose Proposition 15, the nuclear initiative?
