

GOLDEN BEAR WELCOMED

SAN DIEGO—(AP)— California's maritime training ship Golden Bear came home today from its goodwill milk trip to Europe.

The Golden Bear delivered its relief cargo to needy children of France, Greece and Italy. It called at the ports of nine foreign countries.

City officials and civic representatives welcomed Capt. Ralph M. G. Swany and his cadet crew, which includes Earl Warren, Jr., son of the governor.

The ship left here Jan. 24 for the 21,000-mile roundtrip. After two days, it will leave for stops at Long Beach and San Pedro. Another stop is scheduled at Santa Barbara, Sunday through Tuesday. The ship will be welcomed at San Francisco May 19 by Governor Warren, who sponsored the trip.
