

Topics of Discussion

PRICING OF OIL AND NATURAL GAS

Are rewards offered to producers insufficient to induce development of new supplies, as producers maintain, or are they excessive and thereby limit the amount of production as consumers contend?

THE ROLE OF GOVERNMENT IN DEVELOPING ENERGY RESOURCES ON PUBLIC LANDS

The great bulk of undeveloped resources are Federal properties (Outer Continental Shelf and onshore). What is being done to ensure that the development of these nationally owned scarce resources are being used effectively to enhance our national energy plan?

CONSERVATION

Are we serious? If we are, what steps must we take to bring our per capita consumption on energy in line with other advanced economies, e.g. West Germany and Sweden?

About the National Democratic Forum
